Invented Electric Welding and other important inventions in electric lighting and power.

Dr. Frank J. Sprague

Engineer and Inventor; Founder of Sprague Electric Railway and Motor Co.

Inventor of Constant Speed Electric Motor; Multiple Unit System of electric train control; and a system of regeneration used in mountain electric systems and high-speed elevators.

Dr. Charles F. Brush

Dr. Elmer A. Sperry

Electrical Engineer and Inventor; Founder of Sperry Electric Railway Company

Inventor of Gyro-compass; Aeroplane and ship stabilizer; Highest intensity searchlight; Compound inner-combustion engine; Fire control apparatus.

Dr. Edwin W. Rice, Jr.

President of Thomson-Houston and member of Board of Directory, General Electric.
